A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, GEORGIA, TO SET THE MILLAGE RATE IN THE CITY OF JONESBORO, GEORGIA

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Jonesboro, Georgia is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Jonesboro Charter, Sec. 6.11, and Ordinance Sec. 66-31, the Council, by resolution, shall establish a millage rate for the city property tax, a due date, and the time period within which these taxes must be paid; and

WHEREAS, this resolution establishes the City of Jonesboro Millage Rate for 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro desires to adopt this Resolution establishing the Millage Rate for 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, GEORGIA, ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

SECTION 1: MILLAGE RATE. For all real and personal property located in the City of Jonesboro and in Clayton County, Georgia, the calendar year 2026 gross millage for maintenance and operation shall be 9 mills.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any part of this resolution is deemed invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the remainder of this resolution.

SECTION 3. Attorney Authorization. The City Attorney is hereby authorized, by the consent of the City Council, to make such edits, changes, and additions to this resolution as necessary to ensure its compliance with the intent of the City Council, the Charter of the City of Jonesboro, and all applicable laws and ordinances.

SECTION 4. Administrative Provisions. The City Clerk or acting Clerk is hereby directed to forward a duly certified copy of this resolution to the Tax Commissioner of Clayton County, Georgia, upon passage of this resolution.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective January 1, 2026.

SECTION 6. Repealer. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.
