- Chuck Paulus (Jonesboro Resident) Spoke regarding what the taxes are based upon and who pay taxes. Also, spoke about the Key property off of McDonough Road and properties owned by the City.
- Lee Moore (Jonesboro Resident) Spoke regarding increased taxes vs. decrease in amenities, events at Lee Street Park, recommended charging non-residents to attend City events, mentioned Jonesboro being a City of Color, and Park Patrol.
- Pat Sebo-Hand (Jonesboro Resident) Spoke regarding the comment of Chuck Paulus and how the property was deeded to the City.
