I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:47 PM by Jule.

V. New Business - Action Items

- a. **Wall Sign** – 112 South Main Street; Parcel No. **13241D C005**; Signage; **H-1** (Historic District)

The board reviewed the proposed wall sign for Kimberly Lightford's business. Discussion included sign design, letter sizing, and lighting placement due to structural constraints. The sign consists of cast aluminum letters mounted on standoffs with decorative metal accents.

Motion: Mary made a motion to approve the sign with modifications, including reduced letter size (approximately 12–15 inches) and adjusted lighting placement below the decorative band. Shuntate seconded the motion.

- b. **Ground Sign** – 155 Smith Street; Parcel No. 13241A B009; Signage; **R-4** (Single Family District), DESIGNATION OF 155 SMITH ST.AS HISTORIC PROPERTY BY MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL JUNE 13, 2022

i. **Location, lighting, address, landscaping**

The board reviewed the proposed ground sign for the Rosenwald School. Discussion included material specifications (decorative textured block), lighting requirements, sign placement options, address visibility for emergency response, and landscaping requirements. Additional discussion addressed durability concerns based on prior installations.

Motion: Mary made a motion to approve the sign with the following modifications: placement at Option 2 (further from the water meter), inclusion of required lighting, addition of the address on the end cap, and installation of appropriate landscaping. Shuntate seconded the motion.
