<p><b>Requested Action:</b> Work session discussion regarding the establishment of the Jonesboro Education Trust (JET) Pilot Program, a public-private youth investment initiative designed to support early financial literacy, civic engagement, and long-term education savings pathways for Jonesboro students.</p>

<p><b>Is this Item Goal Related?</b> Yes. This item aligns with Council priorities related to youth development, workforce readiness, community engagement, educational attainment, and long-term economic opportunity.</p>		
<p><b>Summary and Background:</b> The Jonesboro Education Trust (JET) is a civic-engagement–driven youth investment initiative designed to introduce financial literacy, savings habits, and community participation beginning at the kindergarten level. The program connects positive civic engagement activities, such as volunteering, family financial literacy participation, and community involvement to education savings incentives funded through public-private partnerships.</p> <p>The proposed 2026–2027 pilot cohort will serve 25 kindergarten students and will be supported through philanthropic, corporate, and financial-institution partnerships rather than general fund expenditures. The pilot establishes a scalable framework designed to grow annually, building a long-term pathway for Jonesboro youth to access post-secondary education, workforce training, or entrepreneurship support.</p> <p>The City’s role will focus on convening partners, supporting community engagement opportunities, verifying participation activities, and providing visibility and program coordination, while private and philanthropic partners fund incentives and account contributions.</p>
