Council to discuss and consider approval of a Pavement Condition Survey.

Requested Action: Recommend approval.

Requirement for Board Action: Approval.

Is this Item Goal Related? Yes, this survey supports maintaining and improving public infrastructure and aligns goals focused on the responsible use of public funds and helps prioritize maintenance and reduce long-term cost.

Summary and Background: The Pavement Condition survey will provide an overview of the City's current roadway conditions. The survey will involve a pavement analysis to identify common pavement issues such as cracking, surface wear, potholes, and other signs of deterioration.

The results of the survey will help city staff prioritize roadway improvements, assist with decision making when allocating funds (budget) and grant opportunities. By identifying maintenance needs early, the city can plan cost effective repairs, extend the life of existing pavement, and maintain safe and reliable streets.

Fiscal Impact: Cost for a Pavement Condition Survey ranges from \$20,000 to \$40,658.
 Funding resources: Prior year.
