### **Savannah Trip – Code of Conduct**

#### **Respect & Conduct**

- Respect for self and others is expected at all times.
- Members must treat their roommates and their belongings with respect. Disrespect, theft, or damaging others' property will not be tolerated.
- In-house fighting or physical altercations will result in immediate dismissal from the trip and parents being required to pick up their child.
- Profanity, inappropriate language, and disrespectful behavior are strictly prohibited.
- All adults and JYCG members are to be addressed formally (e.g., Mayor [Last Name], Councilman/Councilwoman [Last Name]). First names are not to be used unless given permission or outside of the learning experience.
- Members are expected to encourage and support one another as a team.

#### **Appearance & Dress**

- Appropriate dress is expected at all times.
- No pants hanging below the waist.
- Shirts tucked in depending on style.
- General appearance should remain neat and presentable.
- JYCG apparel/tags must be worn when attending official symposium sessions.

#### **Schedules & Curfew**

- The day will begin at 7:00 AM each morning. Members are expected to be awake, dressed, and ready on time to have breakfast and debrief before the itinerary starts.
- Curfew is set at 10:30 PM. At this time, all members must be in their assigned rooms with their roommates. Chaperones will perform room checks.

#### **Group Expectations**

- Members must remain with the group at all times during outings. No one is permitted to leave the group without direct permission from a chaperone.
- Be on time for all scheduled activities. If an emergency arises, mentees must notify their mentor/chaperone immediately.
- Personal electronics & cell phones may be used only during free time or outside of sessions. Students are responsible for their own belongings.
- Snacks will be provided, but mentees are responsible for keeping track of all personal items (including food, clothing, money, and electronics).

#### **Health & Safety**

- If a member becomes sick or an emergency occurs, they must notify a mentor immediately and parents will be contacted and updated as needed.

- Parents will be notified of the whereabouts and well-being of members as necessary throughout the trip.
