AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

In 2022, the Town Council approved the design for a traffic signal at the intersection of SH 60 and Carlson Blvd. The design is complete, and the project has been approved by the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT).

The project went out to bid the week of January 9, 2023 and will close in mid-February. The traffic signal poles are a long lead item and will take at least 22 weeks to arrive. Therefore, Staff is requesting approval to order the traffic signal poles due to the timing and opening of the High School in the fall of 2023. For the safety of the roadway and children going to school, it is Staff's desire to have the intersection operational prior to opening day of school 2023.

The Town requested 3 quotes for the poles and have received 2 quotes back. Quotes received include:

- 1. MH Companies \$139,082.00
- 2. Millerbrand \$96,279.00

Staff is seeking authorization to order the traffic signal poles from Millerbrand in the amount of \$96,279.00.

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The poles will be painted black to match the SH 60 Corridor traffic signal poles.
