Jack will also be working on the lights during this scheduled closure. Sound panels and under counter lights are needed in the Makerspace-Kristi will research. Storage is needed for seasonal LoT items. Storage building can be up to 120 square feet without a permit-per Kristi's finding-research and positive interaction with Town. Placement was discussed – front SW side of parking lot seems most logical temporarily. Kristi will order.

Staff: Laurel Engelbert resigned on September 9<sup>th</sup> to start her new job as Milliken Middle School Librarian. Staff day was 'celebrated' on September 19<sup>th</sup> - Kristie Allbritton took a staff photo and then gave pointers on taking pictures, Tabatha Erb, Social Media Strategist, spoke about appropriate posting and Danara Lowery, CSU Intern, worked with staff on the Glowforge. Staff will be 'field tripping' to other libraries during door installation. Two staffers have expressed interest in full time employment.
