#### **AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:**

In April 2020, the registered voters of the Town of Johnstown were asked to consider providing the Town with an exemption from SB152 which prohibits municipalities from the expenditure of funds for broadband projects. That ballot measure was approved by roughly a 75% - 25% margin in support of the exemption.

In the FY2021 budget, funds were appropriated for the first step in this process which is a broadband needs and financial feasibility study. During preparation of the Request for Proposal (RFP), I had the opportunity to discuss the project with other neighboring community Town Managers. A portion of them also had similar experience with less than desirable internet service from the current providers and were interested in the work we were doing. Consequently, they were in a similar position of wanting to explore a municipal broadband project. During our discussions we proposed the idea that maybe a collaborative option could be a solution that is more financially feasible rather than going it alone.

Each Manager then discussed the idea with their respective Council/Board's to issue a joint and regional RFP for a broadband needs and financial feasibility study. The general consensus the elected officials was this was a project and idea that would be amenable by all governmental entities. Accordingly, as we near completion of the RFP, attached is an Intergovernmental Agreement that outlines the obligations of each party regarding the cooperative Broadband RFP. Those parties involved in the collaborative IGA and Broadband RFP are as shown below. The

Based on the findings of the study, each of the governmental agencies may decide individually how they want to proceed – regionally, individually, or status quo.
