Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 6,671,300 sheets of printing and copy paper!

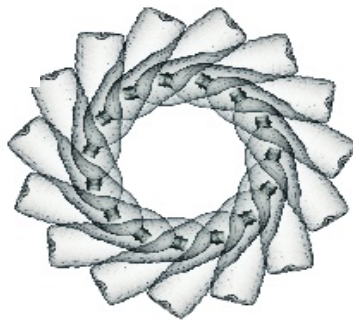
74 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 84 people!



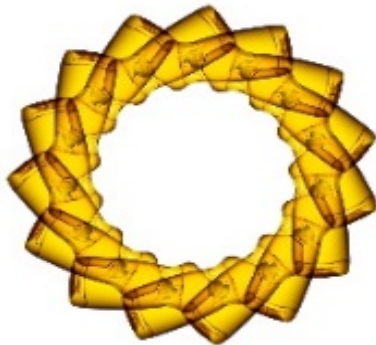
54,751 Kw-Hrs of Electricity
