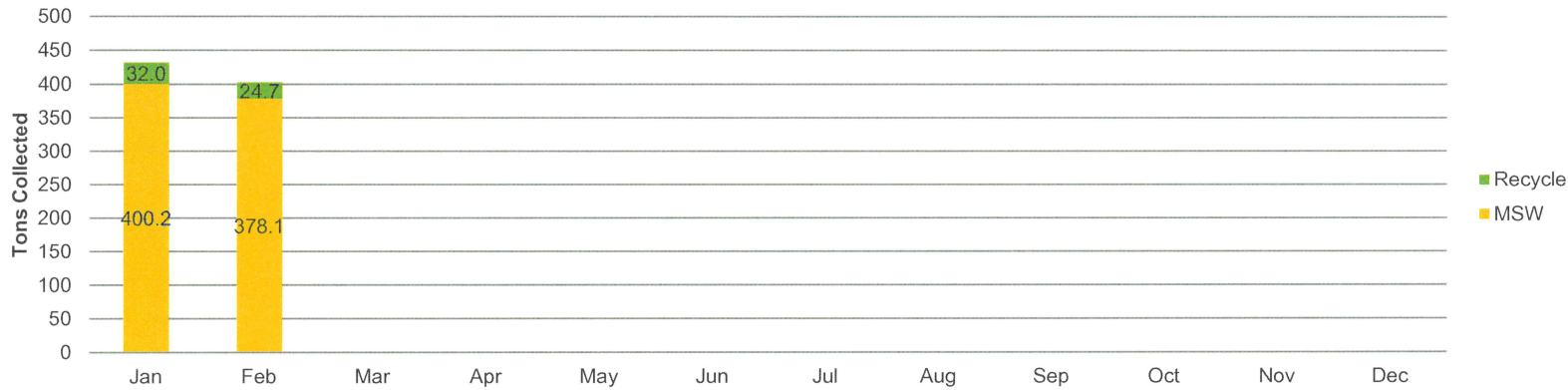




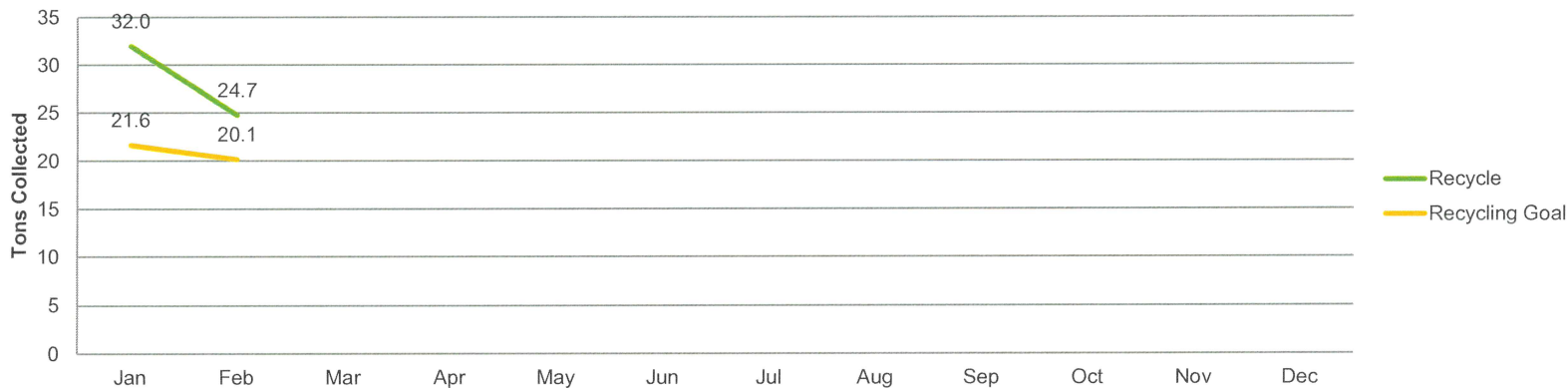

In February 2021, we recycled 25 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

42,348 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

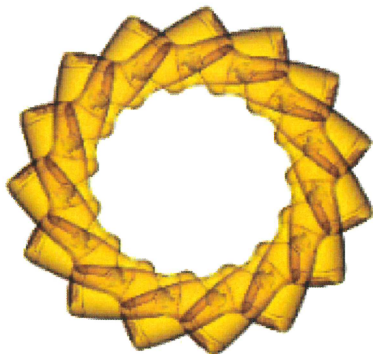
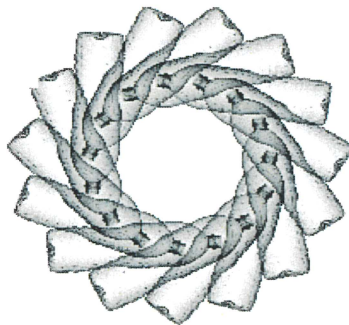
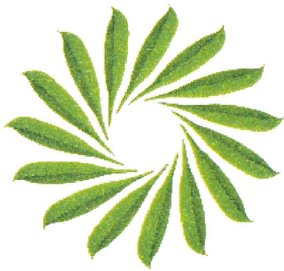
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 3 homes!
