WHEREAS, the Town Council acknowledges that, not only do the farmers and ranchers provide sustenance to the Town, the farmers and ranchers have sustained, and continue to sustain, the economy in and around the Town by providing significant employment and related economic benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council values and honors the Town's farmers and ranchers and all other persons who facilitate the production of meat in and around the Town; and

WHEREAS, to show its appreciation and its support for the industry, the Town Council desires to designate March 20, 2021, as "Eat Meat Day."
