

# Clinical & Community Health Services

#### **Immunizations**

• Routine and recommended vaccines for adults and children, as well as vaccines for travel abroad

#### **Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP)**

• Nurse home visitors provide free support and resource navigation to qualified first-time moms starting in pregnancy through the 2nd birthday

#### Reproductive Health/ Family Planning

• STI testing and treatment, pregnancy tests, birth control, well-woman exams, and HIV prevention treatments

## Women's Wellness Connection (WWC) and WISEWOMAN

• Free breast and cervical cancer screenings, as well as cardiovascular and diabetes screenings for uninsured or underinsured women

#### Children with Special Health Care Needs

• Connects children with special health care needs and their families with support resources

#### **Presumptive Eligibility**

• Immediate temporary medical coverage for children under 19 or pregnant women for up to 60 days



# **Environmental Health Services**

#### Food Safety

• Licenses and inspects retail food establishments and teaches safe food-handling practices

#### **Animal-Related Diseases**

• Investigates diseases that are spread from animals to humans to prevent further spread

#### **Disease Control and Prevention**

• Investigates infectious diseases, responds to outbreaks, provides education and referrals, and documents disease incidence

#### **Health Inspections Programs**

 Inspects for the safe operation of ambulance services, body art establishments, child care centers, and schools



#### **Lead Program**

• Conducts home investigations involving children with elevated blood lead levels

#### **Air Quality Program**

• Addresses air quality complaints, issues open burn permits, inspects stationary sources of air pollution, and monitors air quality

 Provides microbiology and chemistry analyses for drinking water and wastewater
