Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

I hope this letter finds you well and safe at this time. In 2003, the entities included in this letter adopted an Intergovernmental Agreement regarding an Access Control Plan (ACP) for the State Highway 34 corridor. At the time that all parties approved this agreement, the Town of Johnstown chose not to approve this agreement. The specific reasons for no action taken by Johnstown I am not aware of and, quite frankly, those reasons I would hope would be not material at this time. As the Town looks forward and takes a more collaborative approach to our transportation planning, the Town is strongly considering adopting this ACP, as it also compliments the Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) for the Highway 34 corridor
