ADOPTING LARIMER COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (2021)

WHEREAS, the Town of Johnstown, Colorado (the "Town") is a Colorado home rule municipality, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Colorado and the Town's Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is vested with authority to administer the affairs of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes the threat that natural and human-caused hazards, including flooding, wildfires and other such events, pose to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Larimer County and twenty-five jurisdictions within Larimer County, including the Town, have developed a hazard mitigation plan, known as the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021); and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021) sets forth mitigation actions to help minimize and reduce safety threats and damage to private and public property; and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021) was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that adoption of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021) is in the best interests of the Town and desires to adopt such Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JOHNSTOWN, COLORADO, THAT:

- 1. The Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021) is hereby approved and adopted as the Town's hazard mitigation plan for the portions of the Town within Larimer County.
- 2. The Town staff is directed to execute the actions in the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021).
- 3. The Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (2021) shall supersede and replace prior hazard mitigation plans adopted by the Town.
