- 4. Soaking up some Vitamin D and enjoying the Great Outdoors!





Where?

- -Outback DGC-Greeley (22 minutes)






Homes Pioneer Ridge Elementary playground Homes Parking

Who?

For safety purposes, the Disc Golf Course will be available to the public outside of Pioneer Ridge Elementary school hours. It is FREE to play.

The goal of this course is to give everyone in the community an opportunity to learn this great sport and enjoy time with family and friends outdoors. We encourage families to play together and we will give many opportunities for our youth to learn through.





Funding

Weld RE5J School District is providing the funding through grant dollars deemed for wellness education. This funding will go toward course and installation materials.



Safety

Safety is our #1 priority when planning this course. Here are some things we are considering:

- Course will only be accessible to the public during non-school hours.
- 2. Holes that are close to homes on the west and north sides of the park are designed to go out and away from the homes on the initial drive. We have also made shots with trees and out-of-bounds areas to deter shots from drifting toward homes.
- 3. Baskets are designed to stay away from the main field, school, and playground areas.
- Course rules will be posted near the first hole. We will also have a QR code that golfers can scan for rules during play.
- 5. Golfers are responsible for any damage caused by errant discs, and must abide by no trespassing in residents' backyards.



When

Immediately

Upon town approval, we can order the supplies to install the course immediately. Typically it takes 2-4 weeks for all the baskets and installation materials to ship. During this time, we can call 8-1-1 to check all locations for possible underground hazards. With the correct machinery, it will take approximately 1-2 days to dig holes, pour cement, and set the installation kits. Then, we will have to wait at least 24 hours before we can put the baskets in the set installation sleeves.



Installation

Relatively Simple - Can be simpler with the right tools (auger and water tank for mixing cement.)

To install a basket, we need to dig 8" diameter holes up to 20" deep. We place the installation sleeve inside the hole, then then pour concrete into the hole around the sleeve. The sleeve needs to stay perfectly horizontal so the basket will have the perfect angle on it. After the installation sleeve is completely set inside the concrete, we can install the baskets, which piece together easily. There are locks on the sleeve so the baskets cannot be stolen. This also means that the baskets can be moved to a different location if needed.






BASKET SPECS



- Color: Four color options (custom colors available upon request)
- 14 inner and 14 outer chain sets made of 18-8 stainless steel
- Galvanized with a powder coated finish
- Tension screws are included for increased stability
- Approved at the Championship PDGA level
- 3.5" stainless steel deflector band
- Built-in wheel on the base (portable version) Ground sleeve, locking collar, and padlock included (permanent version)
- 19.25" ground sleeve Ground sleeve inner diameter: 49mm
- Pole outside diameter: 48mm
- · Weight: 67lbs (permanent)





Things to Consider

If an auger is available, it would make install much easier. Possible water source to help us mix concrete bags at pin locations?

Trash cans and porta-potty?
