Agenda Description:

Discuss, consider, and possible action of modifying 2.03.005 Identification, Registration Tag, and Microchip.

Background Information:

The current ordinance requires all animals that reside in the city to be registered and microchipped. The two cities that surround Joshua, (Burleson and Cleburne) do not require pets to be registered annually. Many other cities are moving away from this practice and are either doing away with it completely or they are changing the requirement to where all pets must be microchipped.

Tracking annual registrations is very time-consuming and costly. I feel like the time spent each year keeping registrations current could be better utilized by adding patrol hours and being more proactive than reactive in the community. Additionally, such time would allow for more community interaction, adoption events, and community education.

If we were to move to require all pets to be microchipped and do away with the annual registration requirement, I would propose reducing the microchip fee for residents from \$20 to \$12. Additionally, we would participate in National Pet ID Week and offer free microchipping that week.
