



## JOSHUA POLICE DEPARTMENT

### April 2025

In April, the Joshua Police Department was officially notified that we passed the CJIS audit mentioned in last month's Council Report. Implementation of the SOMA software package has been pushed back to the end of May. Apparently, multiple minor issues are still being addressed. We were notified that our department's grant application for new portable radios scored high in the North Central Texas Council of Government's grant review committees and has been approved for funding by the NCTCOG's Executive Board. The only remaining approval/hurdle lies with the Governor's Office who commonly approves funding based on the list sent to them by the COG's. Even with minor adjustments by the Governor's Office, we scored high enough that we can expect funding for our grant application. Our request was for \$66,599.00. With it we intend to replace our current, aging portable radios. Exactly when the funds become available varies from year to year but, we can probably expect funding sometime in the Fall. During this month our department hosted the first of two Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERT) Level I classes for our officers. People often refer to this training as "Active Shooter Training". This training takes two days and I found it to be thorough and very educational. All officers attended this training at the True Life Church located at 301 S. Main in Joshua, Texas. The use of the facilities there was offered by our Chaplain, Pastor Chris Copeland. Airsoft pistols and rifles were used for this training. While they usually do not draw blood or damage walls, I am told that the projectiles cause some pretty intense pain – enough pain to highlight in one's mind the tactical errors leading to being shot. These Airsoft weapons were purchased through a donation from the Joshua Citizen's Police Academy Alumni Association. Our department thanks Chaplain Copeland and the JCPAAA for making this training possible.
