A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, DISAPPROVING THE CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT OF JOHNSON COUNTY BUILDING ACQUISITION PROPOSAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 6.051(b) of the Texas Property Tax Code provides a process by which a central appraisal district may acquire or convey real property or construct or renovate a building or other improvement as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Central Appraisal District of Johnson County has submitted a building acquisition proposal to the taxing units entitled to vote on the purchase of property which is situated in Johnson County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joshua, Texas, is a taxing unit entitled to consider and act upon the proposal in accordance with Section 6.051(b) of the Texas Property Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Joshua has reviewed the Central Appraisal District of Johnson County's building acquisition proposal and desires to formally act upon the proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Joshua hereby **DISAPPROVES** the Central Appraisal District of Johnson County building acquisition proposal.

SECTION 2. The City Secretary is authorized to provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Central Appraisal District of Johnson County as evidence of the City's action on the proposal.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
