AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 1.03.001, "DATE AND TIME OF MEETINGS," OF CHAPTER 1, "GENERAL PROVISIONS," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, TO CONFORM CITY COUNCIL MEETING STARTING TIMES TO CURRENT PRACTICES; MAKING FINDINGS RELATED THERETO; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend its ordinance that currently provides the starting time of City Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires the flexibility to schedule meetings on different days for reasons other than those currently set out in Section 1.03.001 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and correct.

SECTION 2

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, existing Section 1.03.001, "Date and Time of Meetings," contained in Chapter 1, "General Provisions," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Joshua, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 1.003.001 Date and Time of Meetings

There shall be a regularly scheduled city council meeting on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m., and the Mayor may schedule such other special meetings as are necessary to conduct the business of the City."

SECTION 3

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Joshua, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication.
