

CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS PROCLAMATION

Constitution Week September 17–23, 2026

WHEREAS, September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred thirty-ninth anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the delegates to the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States established the framework of our nation's government, secured the blessings of liberty, and continues to protect the rights and freedoms of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Week, observed annually from September 17 through September 23, commemorates the signing of this historic document and serves as an opportunity to educate citizens about the Constitution and the responsibilities of self-government; and

WHEREAS, the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution has promoted the observance of Constitution Week since 1955, and through the efforts of its members continues to encourage the study of the Constitution, American history, and responsible citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joshua recognizes and appreciates the dedication of the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution for sponsoring this observance and for its ongoing commitment to preserving our nation's heritage and educating future generations about the principles upon which the United States was founded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joshua encourages all residents to observe Constitution Week by learning more about the Constitution, reflecting upon the freedoms it guarantees, and participating in activities that strengthen civic knowledge and patriotism.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Kimble, Mayor of the City of Joshua, Texas, on behalf of the City Council, do hereby proclaim September 17–23, 2026, as

and urge all citizens to commemorate this observance by reaffirming the ideals of liberty, justice, equality, and democracy embodied in the Constitution of the United States.
