The Juneau airport is positioned at a critical junction of public interests and private commerce, and plays a tremendously important role in supporting the Juneau community's socioeconomic well-being. Based on my review of recent board packets and minutes, it is apparent the airport is engaged in a wide variety of construction activities, commercial relationships, and safety and regulatory requirements that coincide strongly with my career, and areas of personal interest. As a 10-year employee of Alaska Power & Telephone Company, and prior to that, a 3.5-year employee of the City of Saxman, I have developed diverse experience of direct relevance to service on the Airport Board: - Development and management of regulated procurement processes for state- and federally-funded projects undertaken by power and telecommunication utilities, and a unit of municipal government (the City of Saxman). This has included conducting procurements with international dynamics, compliance with complex Buy American and supply chain standards, and highly unique logistical requirements. - Negotiation and drafting of leases, easements, fuel supply contracts, real estate transactions, equipment purchases, construction contracts, and more. - Experience in applying for and administering state and federal grant funds. This includes over \$85m in recently-awarded USDA grants for multi-year telecommunication projects. - Complex construction and engineering contract management, dispute resolution, and change order resolution, both on the buy- and sell-side. Additionally, as Chairman of the Supervisory Committee for Tongass Federal Credit Union, I am familiar with playing a governance and financial oversight role for a dynamic organization. The Supervisory Committee has overseen audit and regulatory examination activities during dynamic times including acquisition of a another financial institution, opening of new branches, and grant-funded construction projects. Given the strong coincidence between the airport's activities and my existing interests and experience, serving the community as an Airport Board member would be a very engaging and personally satisfying experience that puts my best skills to use within my home community.
