Ord 2022-64 Amendment (via Assemblymember Smith)
Background: On January 3, 2023, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee unanimously
recommended the Assembly adopt Ordinance 2022-64 with one amendment to allow members
of the public to be eligible for subcommittee positions.
Motion: I move to amend Ordinance 2022-64 Section 6 as follows (Ordinance Page 5, line 9):
67.01.230 Subcommittees.
"(b) Special subcommittees. The chairperson—subject to ratification by the PRAC—or
majority of the PRAC may create temporary special subcommittees to facilitate any discrete
PRAC business issue. Membership on subcommittees may include public seats in addition to
PRAC members. Members of such subcommittee are limited to PRAC members. While all
PRAC members may attend and participate in subcommittee proceedings, only designated
subcommittee members may vote. Temporary subcommittees should exist for no longer than
24 months and dissolve upon completion of the enabling charge."
