




# Fundamental Goals

# **Capitol Recycling and Disposal**

**Sustainability Report** 

Capitol Recycling and Disposal provides the City and Borough of Juneau with recycling and disposal services that are safe, convenient and protective of the environment.

The recycling drop-off area (RecycleWorks) is an important part of the community's waste reduction infrastructure and is provided by the City and Borough of Juneau. For information about what can be recycled at RecycleWorks and other recycling services available in the community, go to www.juneaurecycling.com.

Recyclables delivered to RecycleWorks are processed at JMK Fibers, WM's state-of-the art recycling center in Tacoma, Washington, JMK is a regional materials recovery facility (MRF) that processes, bales and then sends recyclables to end markets so they can made into new products.

For material that cannot be recycled, the landfill is engineered with environmental protection systems that meet or exceed rigorous government regulations and are subject to highly regulated monitoring and reporting requirements. Systems include leachate collection and removal as well as landfill gas collection and control. The facility accepts primarily municipal solid waste (household waste), construction and demolition debris, industrial waste, and special waste. Capitol Recycling and Disposal does not accept hazardous waste.

# Disposal rates as of Feb. 1

Type of Waste	Price	Minimum * Charge
Household Garbage	\$198/ton	\$141.18
Construction Debris	\$198/ton	\$141.18
Asbestos	\$330/ton	\$235.30
Medical Waste	\$352/ton	\$250.99
Special Waste	\$363/ton	\$258.33
Metal	\$55/ton	\$39.22

All loads must be secured prior to entering the landfill

Minimum charge is a 1/2 ton (1000 lbs).

Loads are charged by tonnage rates listed along with the appropriate taxes, minus weight of the vehicle. Pricing cannot be calculated per vehicle

All rejected recycling loads are subject to household garbage rates.
