29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the Lemon Creek Multimodal Path will be a complex project involving altiple elements of transportation and recreational infrastructure, and funds are urgently eded to support the planning, design, and construction of this multi-phase project; and WHEREAS, CBJ has allocated \$1,100,000 of Capital Improvement Funding for the mon Creek Multimodal Path project, and an additional \$1,500,000 may be available for e project from an extension of the 1% sales tax approved by the people of Juneau in the 22 municipal election; and  WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau Assembly and the Community Development epartment have allocated significant resources to the Lemon Creek Multimodal Path oject and intend to allocate further resources to the project in future; and

46 WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau Systemic Racism Review Committee has 47 considered the past inequitable allocation of resources that has deprived the Lemon Creek 48 Neighborhood of many of the same improvements and amenities, which are enjoyed by the 49 people of Juneau residing in other neighborhoods and areas of Alaska's Capital City; and 50 51 WHEREAS, TAP Grant Funding will help make it possible for the scope of work to 52 include comprehensive planning of the Lemon Creek Multimodal Path project in a way that 53 maximizes community and neighborhood input, so the resulting path will best serve the 54 people who will use it the most, while enhancing the neighborhood for all and protecting fish 55 and wildlife habitat. 56 57 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF 58 JUNEAU, ALASKA: 59 60 The City and Borough of Juneau seeks TAP Grant Funding for the first 61 phase of the Lemon Creek Multimodal Path, and funding in the amount of \$3,000,000. 62 63 The City and Borough of Juneau acknowledges the requirement for a 64 minimum 9.03% local match for TAP Grant Funding, and, in accordance with Alaska law on 65 encumbering funds in future fiscal years, intends to commit to providing matching funds in 66 the amount of \$1,000,000, or 25% of the current project budget, as a local match in the event 67 of successful completion of the TAP Grant Funding process. 68 69 **Section 3.** The City and Borough of Juneau intends to operate and maintain the 70 Lemon Creek Multimodal Path upon construction. 71 72 **Section 4.** A successful application for and subsequent receipt of TAP Grant funds is 73 an essential component of the budgetary planning and execution process for the Lemon 74 Creek Multimodal Path project. 75 76 **Section 5.** The City and Borough of Juneau encourages the TAP Statewide Project 77 Evaluation Board to allocate \$3,000,000 to the Lemon Creek Multimodal Path in order to 78 make it possible for this important project to become a reality as soon as possible. 79 80 **Section 6.** Effective Date.
