Sealaska collaborated with leaging the "fishery-forestry working group" designated by the legislture to craft the State of Alaska's first comprehensive forest practices act and regulations. Involved two years of negotiation between loggers, fishermen, environmentallists to write a consensus act that all supported. The diverse entities recommeded that the draft act be enacted without amendment. The Alaska legislature unamiously approved the proposed act without amendment and was signed by the governor.

Directed a ten year effort to finalize Sealaska Corporation's Alaska Natives Claims Settlement Act land selection entitlement and land selections across SE Alaska. Federal legislation was passed in 2014 enshrining the settlement agreements between Sealaska, logging industry, fishing industry, US Forest Service, local and National Environmental organizations, the United States Congress, and SE Alaska local governments.
