ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2023-26(c)

An Ordinance Creating a Short-Term Residential Rental Registration Program and Providing for a Penalty.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau is facing a severe housing shortage; and

WHEREAS, an increase in short-term rental properties is believed to be one of the factors having an impact on available long-term housing, but there is a lack of quality data to understand the extent of that impact; and

WHEREAS, short-term rental listings are very fluid and utilize multiple platforms; and

WHEREAS, sales tax account numbers are considered confidential information; and

WHEREAS, “gig economy” entrepreneurs operating businesses through third-party platforms like Airbnb may not understand that it is their responsibility to register with the sales tax office and collect and remit sales tax and hotel bed taxes; and

WHEREAS, the CBJ places great importance on the need to treat similarly situated businesses the same, and that sales tax compliance is a necessary feature of an equitable marketplace; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to ensure that CBJ has adequate information so that it can have proper policy consideration of other regulatory ideas and debate whether they are necessary or not.

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2 THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU,
3 ALASKA:

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5 **Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and
6 shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

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8 **Section 2. Amendment of Title.** Title 69 Revenue and Taxation is amended by adding
9 a new Chapter 40, to read:

10 **Chapter 69.40 – SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL RENTAL REGISTRATION PROGRAM**

11 **69.40.005 Short-Term Residential Rental Registration Program Intent.**

12 The purpose and intent of this chapter is to require registration of short-term residential
13 rentals within the City and Borough of Juneau. An operator offering or using a property as a
14 short-term residential rental shall annually register such property in the short-term residential
15 rental registry maintained by the CBJ Sale Tax Office.

16 **69.40.010 Definitions.**

17 The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this chapter shall have the
18 meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different
19 meaning.

20
21 *Guest* means an individual, corporation, partnership or association paying monetary or
22 other consideration for the use of a short-term rental.

23 *Operator* means a person, firm, corporation or other legal entity who furnishes, offers for
24 rent or otherwise makes available in the City and Borough rooms for monetary or other
25 consideration, whether acting directly or through an agent or employee.

Person means an individual natural person.

2 *Property and properties* means a real estate offered by an operator as a short-term
3 residential rental.

4 *Rent and rents* mean the amount paid or promised, in terms of money, as consideration for
5 the use by a transient of a room in a hotel, motel or other place of public accommodation.

6 *Short-Term Residential Rental* means a dwelling unit that is rented, leased, or otherwise
7 advertised for occupancy for a period of less than 30 days.

8 *Transient* means a person who occupies or rents a unit, room or rooms for fewer than 30
9 consecutive days for the purpose of habitation.

10 **69.40.020 Registration required.**

11
12 (a) The operator of a short-term residential rental must register with the CBJ sales tax office
13 on a form or platform specified by the CBJ prior to offering a unit for rent.

14 (b) Registration must be renewed annually.

15 (c) The CBJ will provide a rental registration number for each registered short-term
16 residential rental. The registration number must be displayed on each advertisement or public
17 listing for a short-term residential rental that the operator or operator's designee maintains.

18 (d) There is no fee for registration.

19 (e) The operator shall provide the CBJ with the following at the time of registration:

20 (1) Their State business license number.

21 (2) Name, address, phone number, and email address for the operator or operator's
22 designee.

23 (3) ~~Contact information for an emergency point of contact for the operator or operator's~~
24 ~~designee who is responsible for responding to complaints or emergencies in a timely~~

2 manner, in person, if required by public safety personnel, or over the phone or by
3 email at any time of day.

4 (3) A general description of the short-term residential rental unit, to include: address,
5 property type, number of bedrooms, and capacity, ~~and amenities provided.~~

6 (f) If there is a change in the information submitted pursuant to subsection (e) of this section,
7 a new registration must be completed within ~~ten~~ 30 business days.

8
9 **69.40.030 Penalty.**

10 (a) Renting, or offering for rent, a short-term residential rental without complying with the
11 registration requirement in 69.40.020 is prohibited.

12 (b) An operator required to register a property pursuant to this chapter who offers or uses
13 such property without being registered is subject to a penalty in the amount of \$25 per
14 violation. A separate violation shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a
15 property is offered or used as a short-term residential rental without registration. Such
16 operator may not offer or use, or continue to offer or use such property for a short-
17 term residential rental, unless and until the penalty is paid and the property is properly
18 registered.

19
20 **69.40.040 Exemptions.**

21 (a) The registration required under this chapter shall not be required of:

22 Hotels required to keep a register under ~~Title~~ Chapter 20.10 and taxed pursuant to ~~Title~~
23 Chapter 69.07.

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2 **Section 3. Amendment of Section.** CBJC 03.30.070 Violations; civil fines, is
3 amended to read:

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5 **03.30.070 Violations; civil fines.**

6 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the CBJ Code to the contrary, the offenses listed in the
7 table below shall be considered violations subject to a civil fine not to exceed that set forth in
8 the table below; payment of the listed civil fine shall be accepted in satisfaction of the violation;
9 and the violation shall be subject to the procedure set forth in CBJ 03.30.075—03.30.085:

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17 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective ~~30~~ 90 days after its
18 adoption.
