CREATE AGE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY:

In 2023, the CBJ Juneau Assembly joined the AARP Age-Friendly States and Communities Network. friendly communities serve those aged 8 to 80, ensuring age friendly housing, and age friendly recreational and social spaces for Juneau's aging healthy and active population, as well as those with supportive needs.

Universal Age-Friendly Housing

30% of Juneau's population is over 55 and that cohort is growing. Retirees want to retire in the community we've grown to love.

JCOA is promoting Universal Housing design elements that results in accessible housing, allowing aging in place with minimal assistance.

This includes housing that is minimalistic yet functional (Tiny Houses, congregate communities).

A possible positive benefit for Juneau with our tight housing market: Seniors may open up housing for families needing larger spaces when transitioning into senior friendly housing.
