

CBJ Updates for JCOS: October 2, 2024 Regular Meeting

Update from CDD, Minta Montalbo:

The draft Blueprint Downtown Area Plan will be introduced at the Assembly on Oct 21st, with the public hearing set for Nov 18. The COW moved it out of committee with a recommendation to Adopt as Ordinance.

Update from EPW, Dianna Robinson:

Flood debris collection: CBJ is still collecting some materials from affected residents still working to remove water damaged items from their home. Email floodresponse@juneau.gov to have flood debris picked up.

Waste characterization study: the draft study was put out for an informal public comment period in mid-September. We are waiting on the final draft from our contractor, Cascadia Consulting.

Solid waste disposal options study: this study is on-track and we will have a draft study along with public presentations to the Assembly in February/March 2025.

Community Change Grant: we are putting together an application for the EPA Community Change Grant program (\$10-20 million, no match) to construct the majority of our Waste Campus, including a transfer station building, new HHW, a reuse building, and potentially a recycling center. We will also be applying for a new recycling center under the EPA Solid Waste Infrastructure for Recycling grant program. CCG is due in November, SWIFR is due in December.
