Proposal for Memorial Bench for Steve Wolf

Location: The approved location by the Board and desired by the family is at the Lower Nordic Loop Meadow. Slightly in from the pull out parking by the rock-there is flat meadow ground there. This will be accessible from the parking area to accommodate individuals with limited mobility.

Design:

Two Design proposals are included. The approved bench will include a roof to provide protection and seating for nordic skiers and hikers all year round.

Design 1:

7ft x 7xft footprint open timber frame structure using $4" \times 4"$ cedar timber for framing. Gravel pad (graded for accessibility) with concrete footings for the structure Free standing wooden bench - Reference images provided for preliminary bench design Metal roof with a 4/12 pitch for all weather protection

Design 2:

10ft x 8ft footprint timber frame construction using 6" x 6" timbers (hemlock or spruce) Gravel pad (graded for accessibility) with concrete footings for the structure Metal roof with a 4/12 pitch for all weather protection 3 walls provide wind and weather protection Potential for a design element utilizing recycled skis on two side walls Horseshoe bench seating built into the structure
