Materials

This is the material for a 8' x 8' deck on the shore with a 14' staircase descending to the river, I used this because it is close to what I want to do.

14' stair stringers x 3pc @ \$58 each. \$174

8' deck boards for deck floor. 17pc @ \$6ea \$102

6' decking boards for stair treads 14pc @ \$5 \$70

8' deck hand rails 4pc @ \$20ea \$80

2" x 2" deck spindles for deck and steps

130pc @ \$1.50 each \$192

14' hand rail for steps 2pc @ \$12ea \$24

4" x 4" treated posts 14pc @ \$11ea \$154

2" x 6" treated deck framing 8pc @ \$9ea \$72

Deck plates for 4 X 4 post to sit on 14pc @ \$27ea \$378

2" deck screws for deck and steps 10lb box \$60

Supplies
