Re: Proposed No-Parking – Various Locations

Background information:

Due to concerns raised by residents, staff, and changing operations, we are proposing three updates to the 7.12 Parking Regulations section of municipal code. The three areas include:

- 1) A curve along W. 12th Street behind the Kaukauna Housing Authority/ Statesburg Apartments; proposed to be no parking between signs.
- 2) A single stall on Doty Street near the Post Office; proposed to be No Parking, except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
- 3) Updates to the Districts as defined under 7.12(1)(bg) Parking prohibited during street sweeping and fall leaf pickup; proposed to match new collection routes.

Strategic Plan:

This recommendation is for the safety and wellbeing of pedestrians and traffic navigating the areas and for the safe and efficient operations of City Street Department.

Budget: Minor expenses for paint and signage.

Staff Recommended Action:

Direct the City Attorney to draft the necessary ordinance changes to restrict parking on the north side of W. 12th Street along a curve, restrict parking for one stall on the north side of Doty Street, and update the Districts for section 7.12(1)(bg) to reflect the new collection routes.
