## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR PARCEL 322095601

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Kaukauna, having reviewed the recommendation of the City Plan Commission regarding the proposed Special Exception for the property described below and having scheduled a public hearing then to be decided by the Common Council; and

SECTION 1: That the following described property:

A REDIVISION OF LOT 2 AND 3 OF CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP 5680, LOT 1 AND 2 OF CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP NO. 5682, VACATED ARBOR WAY, ALL BEING PART OF LOTS 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14 AND ALL OF LOT 10 AND PART OF THE UNIMPROVED ROAD (66.0 FEET) AS LYING BETWEEN SAID LOTS AS PLATTED IN THE SUBDIVISION OF PRIVATE CLAIM 35 IN 1858, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST ¼ AND SOUTHEAST ¼ OF THE SOUTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 11, NORTHWEST ¼ AND NORTHEAST ¼ OF THE NORTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 14, SOUTHEST ¼ OF THE SOUTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 10 AND NORTHEAST ¼ OF THE NORTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 15, T21N, R18E, CITY OF KAUKAUNA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, WISCONSIN
