

Municipal Disposal Site Use Agreement

Access cards for use of the Kaukauna Municipal Disposal Site may be purchased at a cost is \$25 per year. The card access is good for 365 days, and must be renewed at \$25.00 for continued access. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged for replacement of lost or stolen access cards. Please notify us as soon as possible of any lost or stolen cards.

Location: Corner of W. Third Street and Bicentennial Court, behind the SPaR Building. Please enter from W. Third Street and exit onto Bicentennial Court.

Hours: 6:30 AM - 8:00 PM daily.

What is accepted: Residential waste only: Yard waste, small amounts of brush, excess garbage, excess recyclables, and waste oil.

- All recyclables must be placed in those receptacles designated for recyclables.
- Recyclables must be dumped out of bags or containers.
- Waste oil must be poured into the waste oil receptacle.
- All yard waste must be dumped out of bags or containers (unless within biodegradable bag).
- All yard waste must be free of any debris or other non-yard waste material.
- Please pile brush neatly, with cut ends pointing outward.
- Any waste deposited in the Disposal Site must have been generated in the City of Kaukauna.
- Waste from any business or commercial operation is prohibited.

What is not accepted: Electronics, white good (appliances), construction material, refrigerants, toxic waste, hazardous waste, explosives, ammunition, chemicals, furniture, mattresses, batteries, tires, flammable liquids, paints (other than dried latex). For information about the safe and proper disposal of these items, visit the Outagamie County website.

PLEASE NOTE: You are responsible for appropriate disposal and use of the Municipal Disposal Site. Violations of Kaukauna Municipal Code may result in revocation of access and fines of up to \$328.00

Kaukauna Municipal Code Section 11.11 (4)(f) Municipal Disposal Site. City of Kaukauna Municipal Disposal site is available to residents only for excess residential waste, via an access card registered to a specific address.

- (1) Location. The City of Kaukauna Municipal Disposal site is located at the intersection of W. 3rd St. and Bicentennial Ct.
- (2) Hours of Operation. Hours shall be posted within the Public Works section of the City of Kaukauna's website and upon request within the Street Department located at 207 Reaume Avenue.
- (3) Items allowed via access card. Yard waste, brush, garbage, waste oil and recycling.
- (4) Scavenging of solid waste or recyclables in the Municipal Disposal Site. It is prohibited for any person other than authorized City employees or recycling contractor to go through, sort or take anything from Municipal Disposal Site. Firewood, mulch, compost, and wood chips are not included in this prohibition.
