**Authorization to seek bids for Project #6-24, Thousand Islands Boardwalk Reconstruction**

**Background**

The Engineering Department is completing plans to reconstruct a series of trails through the Thousand Islands Conservancy Area. This project will include removal of the old boardwalks, installation of steel footings, construction of new boardwalks with safety edges and railings in select locations, and appropriate restoration of the affected areas. This boardwalk reconstruction is planned to be completed over 2 phases. Phase 1 will be the main focus for this project, with phase 2 being bid as an alternate. If prices are good, both phases may be awarded on this project. A map is shown below highlighting in red the trails that are to be reconstructed in Phase 1 (1,364 Feet), and in black Phase 2 (1,343 Feet), along with a visual example of a finished boardwalk.
