Planning for Future Growth – Sewer Service Areas

Background

Two potential growth areas for the City of Kaukauna on the south side of the Fox River include areas to the east of Haas Road toward Brown County and areas around the Konkapot Creek corridor. The City currently has an sanitary sewer interceptor pipe extended to south of CTH CE along the Konkapot Creek with a service area shown on the attached in yellow. Extending this pipe along the stream corridor would allow the City to serve approximately 980 Acres. The area to the east of Haas Road, shown in red on the attached map is not serviceable by the City at this time. In order to service some or all of the approximately 3,800 Acres shown, it is likely that a new interceptor sewer would be needed, crossing the Fox River.

Currently, East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission and Heart of the Valley Metropolitan Sewerage District are beginning long range planning for future growth areas and sewer service areas in the Fox Valley. Plan Commission discussions will help steer City staff work with these entities during the planning process.

Staff would like to discuss the future planning goals for this area and determine if engineering studies should proceed for either or both growth areas.

Staff Recommended Action

Direct staff to pursue planning options for future growth areas, per discussion.
