**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN
AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE WELL NO. 14 EMERGENCY GENERATOR TO JAMES DAY
CONSTRUCTION, INC. DBA COASTAL MOUNTAIN ELECTRIC**

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid for the Well No. 14 Emergency Generator was published in the Kerman News on October 19, 2022 and was sent electronically and mailed to all construction trade journals specified for the City by the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission in accordance with the City's Formal Contract Procedures and California Public Contract Code Section 22037 and;

WHEREAS, the Project consists of the procurement and installation of an emergency generator and associated equipment and improvements at the City's Well No. 14 Site, within the City of Kerman; and

WHEREAS, the following bids for the Project were publicly opened and read aloud at the Kerman City Hall on November 3, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.:

James Day Construction, Inc. dba Coastal Mountain Electric	\$899,989.00

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Estimate was \$750,000 for the Base Bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, the Well No. 14 Emergency Generator be awarded to: James Day Construction, Inc. dba Coastal Mountain Electric, 14832 Lakeshore Dr., Clearlake, CA 95422 in the amount of Eight Hundred and Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine Dollars and Zero Cents (\$899,989.00).
2. The City Manager is authorized to sign the City's standard form of agreement for construction projects, as contained in the bid package on behalf of the City of Kerman.
