**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN  
AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE WELL 33 PILOT HOLE PROJECT  
TO SOUTH VALLEY COMPANIES INC.**

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid for the Well 33 Pilot Hole Project was published in the Kerman News on December 6, 2023 and was sent electronically and mailed to all construction trade journals specified for the City by the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission in accordance with the City's Formal Contract Procedures and California Public Contract Code Section 22037; and

WHEREAS, the Project will perform a hydrogeological investigation, consisting of drilling and water testing activities to a depth of 950 feet, for establishing water quality and production capacity at a privately owned parcel on the northside of Kearney Boulevard at its intersection with Kenneth Avenue, within the City of Kerman; and

WHEREAS, the following bids for the Project were publicly opened and read aloud at the Kerman City Hall on January 10, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.:

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Estimate was \$379,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated by reference.
2. Upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, the Council awards the Well 33

Pilot Hole Project to South Valley Companies, Inc., 19325 Flightpath Way, Bakersfield, CA 93308 in the amount of Three Hundred and Eighty-Six Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$386,500.00) which is incorporated by reference.

3. The City Manager is authorized to sign the City's standard form of agreement for construction projects, as contained in the bid package on behalf of the City of Kerman.
4. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
