SUBJECT: California Cities Week (JAJ)

RECOMMENDATION: Council adopt a Resolution recognizing April 19-25, 2026, as California Cities Week and encouraging civic involvement in the City.

DISCUSSION:

As sponsored by the California League of Cities, April 19-25, 2026 is “California Cities Week”, which is designated as a celebration dedicated to California’s 483 cities and honoring the passionate people who serve them.

California Cities Week is a time to highlight the impact of local government and the ways cities make life better for all Californians. Cities may differ wildly from each other, but they all share a commitment to public service and their communities. When people go to a park, drive on roads, visit the library, or call 911, that is local government at work.

By adopting a resolution (**Attachment ‘A’**) the City of Kerman joins in promoting a statewide effort celebrating the vital importance of cities and towns throughout California. Former Downey Mayor and current Assembly Member Blanca Pacheco authored a statewide resolution, ACR 143, commemorating California Cities Week, and the Assembly will vote on the resolution in April.
