SUBJECT: Award of Contract for Kerman Northwest Park to American Paving Co. (JJ)

RECOMMENDATION: Council by motion adopt resolution awarding contract for Kerman Northwest Park to American Paving Co. in the amount of \$694,477.00 and authorize the City Manager to sign the contract.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Northwest Park will be located in the northwest quadrant of the City, at Kenneth Avenue and San Joaquin Avenue. The development of the park will include concrete flatwork (sidewalk), landscape planting, and a landscape irrigation system. The Project was advertised and bids were received from six contractors on Wednesday, July 26, 2023 and the results are as follows:

Staff has reviewed the bid submitted by American Paving Co., along with information regarding their previous work experience. Based on review, Staff has determined the bid received to be responsive and American Paving Co. to be a responsible contractor.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total estimated Project cost is \$918,500, including design, construction, construction management, and contingency. The City has received a Prop 68 Per Capita Grant from the California

Department of Parks and Recreation in the amount of \$187,422 for the Project. The remaining \$731,078 will be funded with a combination of Park Development Impact Fees and Measure M.
