SUBJECT: Award of Contract for Fiscal Year 22/23 Street Rehabilitation Project to AJ

Excavation, Inc. (JJ)

RECOMMENDATION: Council by motion adopt resolution awarding contract for Fiscal Year 22/23 Street Rehabilitation Project to AJ Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$1,039,350.00 and authorize the City Manager to sign the contract.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The FY 22/23 Street Rehabilitation Project is included in the City's Capital Improvement Plan and will consist of the rehabilitation of the existing pavement on 2nd Street between California Avenue and G Street, 3rd Street between California Avenue and Kearney Boulevard, El Mar and San Joaquin Avenue between 1st Street and 4th Street, 4th Street between San Joaquin Avenue and El Mar Avenue, and 3rd Street between Stanislaus Avenue and San Joaquin Avenue. Rehabilitation will include a combination of full reconstruction, pulverize and overlay, and application of slurry seal. The Project will also include the reconstruction of curb and gutter, valley gutter, and sidewalk where damaged, construction of new ADA compliant curb ramps and alley drive approaches, and striping and signage improvements. The Project will also replace water services on El Mar Avenue that have been prone to leaks and breaks, resulting in numerous pavement patches.

The City advertised for bids for the Project and bids were received from six contractors on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, and the results are as follows:

Staff has reviewed the bid submitted by AJ Excavation, Inc., along with information regarding their previous work experience. Based on review, Staff has determined the bid received to be responsive and AJ Excavation, Inc. to be a responsible contractor.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total estimated Project cost is \$1,402,000, including design, construction management, inspection, and contingency. The City has budgeted \$1,500,000 for the Project from Local Transportation Funds
