**WHEREAS**, National Police Week, observed annually in May and culminating on Peace Officers Memorial Day on May 15, honors law enforcement officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty and recognizes those who continue to serve with courage and integrity; and

**WHEREAS**, these observances encourage the public to show appreciation through acts such as wearing blue, sending messages of thanks, sharing positive stories, learning about the roles of law enforcement, and supporting the missions they carry out on behalf of their communities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, that the City Council of the City of Kerman hereby proclaims that January 9<sup>th</sup> be recognized as National Law Enforcement Appreciation Day and that the designated week in May be recognized as National Police Week. These observances serve as a time to honor and thank all law enforcement officers and law enforcement support personnel for their dedication, sacrifice, and commitment to public service.
