**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN
APPROVING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 3 FOR THE HART RANCH
COMMUNITY PARK PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Council awarded the construction contract for the Hart Ranch Community Park Project to Avison Construction, Inc. (Avison) on November 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Avison was issued a construction activities Notice to Proceed with a start date of February 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, to date, two contract change orders totaling \$31,644 have been approved for costs related to splash park pad colors and the addition of three backflow preventers to the on-site water system; and

WHEREAS, Contract Change Order No. 3 (CCO3) is necessary for procurement and installation of a splash park water re-circulation system, revisions to the on-site prefabricated restroom, and revisions to the percolation basin edge treatment as follows:

- The addition of a water circulation system associated to the splash park play area in the amount of \$603,189, and
- Revisions to the on-site prefabricated restroom in the amount of \$174,565, and
- Revisions to the percolation basin edge treatment in the amount of \$3,587.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN RESOLVES as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated by reference.
2. Based on the recitals set forth above, and upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, the Council approves CCO3 for the Hart Ranch Community Park Project to Avison Construction, Inc., in the amount of Seven Hundred Eighty-One Thousand and Three Hundred and Forty-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$781,341).
3. The City Manager is authorized to sign CCO3.
4. Upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, the Council authorizes an additional amount of Six Hundred and Twenty-Two Thousand and Seven Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$622,700) as contingency for use on unforeseen construction needs. The City Manager upon the recommendation of the City Engineer is authorized to sign change orders less than \$50,000.

5. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
