SUBJECT: Appointment of Members to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission and to the Planning Commission (TJ & JJ)

RECOMMENDATION: Council by motion:

1. Adopt resolution approving appointments by Mayor Pacheco of two applicants to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission; and
2. Adopt resolution approving appointment by Mayor Pacheco of one applicant to the Planning Commission.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission currently has two vacancies, for three-year terms beginning January 1, 2025, and expiring on December 31, 2027.

An announcement for vacancies was published in the Kerman News and posted on the City website with an application deadline of Tuesday, October 22, 2024. No applications were received by the first deadline and it was extended to Wednesday, November 20, 2024.

Five applications (**Exhibit 'A' to Attachment 'A'**) were received for the two Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission vacancies and the Mayor appointed Mike Teixeira and Jennifer Coleman-Antuna for appointment to the open three-year term positions.

The Planning Commission currently has two vacancies for three-year terms beginning January 1, 2025, and expiring on December 31, 2027. An announcement for vacancies was published in the Kerman News and posted on the City website with an application deadline of Tuesday, December 31, 2024.

One application (**Exhibit 'A' to Attachment 'B'**) was received for the two Planning Commission vacancies and the Mayor appointed Cory Molloy for appointment to one of the open positions for a three-year term. Staff will re-advertise the call for applications to try and fill the remaining vacancy.

The applicants have been invited to attend the City Council meeting and may be asked to introduce themselves, share their interest in service in these capacities and answer any questions the City Council may have.

Members of the public will also have the opportunity to address the City Council on the proposed appointments.

The City Council shall consider the Mayor's nominations and consider their approval by motion to approve the appointments per City Council, resolutions (**Attachment 'A'**) and (**Attachment 'B'**) are attached to this report.
