A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000 et seq.) requires local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes, and to conduct a biennial review and revise them if necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) has adopted a regulation (2 Cal. Code of Regs. 18730) which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code which may be incorporated by reference in an agency's code, and which may be amended by the FPPC to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act, following public notice and hearings; and

WHEREAS, amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC have previously been incorporated by reference in Resolution 22-71, which, together with the list of designated positions and disclosure categories adopted from time to time by the City Council constitutes the Conflict of Interest Code for the City of Kerman; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted its biennial review of the current Conflict of Interest Code which the City last reviewed in 2022 pursuant to Government Code Section 87300; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined amendments to the Code are necessary in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations, and guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, having undertaken its biennial review of the City's Conflict of Interest Code, the City Council hereby confirms that an amendment to the Code (**Exhibit** 'A') is required at this time and accepts the updated 2024 Local Agency Biennial Notice.
