RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERMAN, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING DONATION GRANT DEED RELATING TO PARCEL 89844-1 TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, Kerman Unified School District (KUSD) recently constructed Harvest Elementary; and

WHEREAS, KUSD is required to construct public access improvements for school traffic circulation to and from State Route 180 onto recently constructed First Street; and

WHEREAS, the improvements will consist of a signalized pedestrian facility, pavement, curb, gutter and sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the public access improvements are in an ultimate Caltrans right-of-way and require Caltrans permitting approval; and

WHEREAS, City Parcel 89844-1 consisting of 1,791 square feet is located adjacent to a Caltrans' right-of-way to the east, west, and south and prevents the necessary configuration for establishing the ultimate right of way and is in physical conflict with necessary public access improvements; and

WHEREAS, grant deed donation from the City to the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is necessary for completion of KUSD's permitting process with Caltrans; and

WHEREAS, Parcel 89844-1 cannot serve as anything other than street right-of-way and;

WHEREAS, the transfer of Parcel 89844-1 and completion of the public improvements will benefit not only the KUSD Project but also the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of Parcel 89844-1 from the City to Caltrans will relieve the City of future maintenance obligations of the parcel which based on its location cannot be used for purposes other than street right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kerman resolves and orders as follows:

- 1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated by reference.
- 2. The City Council hereby approves the Donation Grant Deed attached hereto and incorporated by reference
- 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Donation Grant Deed.

4. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
