SUBJECT: A Request for Public Convenience or Necessity for a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer and Wine) ABC License for Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra (Fast N Easy) Located at 14195 W Whitesbridge Rd. (JRO)

RECOMMENDATION: Council by motion, review and consider adoption of a Resolution Adopting Findings of Public Convenience or Necessity for a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer & Wine) ABC License for Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra (Fast N Easy) Located at 14195 W Whitesbridge Rd. (which is pending consideration of a Conditional Use Permit).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On January 23, 2023, staff received a complete application for a Public Convenience or Necessity (PCN) request regarding an application for a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer & Wine) alcohol license (ABC license), from Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra (Fast N Easy) located at 14195 W Whitesbridge Rd. The subject site is in undue concentrated Census Tract 40.06. As a result of the undue concentration of ABC licenses in this census tract, under section 23958.4 of the Business and Professions Code, the Council must determine within 90 days of notification of a completed application that a PCN would be served by the issuance of the ABC license.

DISCUSSION:

Project Proposal

Applicants Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra wish to include the sale of beer and wine as a component of a convenience store to be developed in association with a fueling station and a drive-through restaurant. Before an ABC license is issued by the State Department of Alcohol Beverage Control, the Council must first determine by making findings that ABC sales would serve a public convenience or necessity (PCN). The applicants are proposing ABC sales between 6 AM and 1 AM. Project development, including ABC sales will be subject to the Site Plan Review (SPR) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP) process. Key operational and development requirements will be determined by the respective review body (e.g. Community Development Director and Planning Commission).

Council Policy

Historically, the Council considered PCN requests for convenience stores on a case-by-case basis. The case-by-case basis approach was determined to be non-objective by Council. In order to address concerns regarding an objective review of PCN and ABC sales, the Council recently adopted Ordinance No. 23-02, requiring all new alcohol sales to procure a CUP. Additionally, specific distance restrictions were imposed as part of the CUP review and consideration process. The proposed resolution approving the PCN with findings expressly noting there is a pending application for an Alcohol

Conditional Use Permit and that approval of the Council resolution does not pre-commit the City to an approval of said CUP. The project applicants are currently awaiting a public hearing date for CUP 2023-03 and SPR 2022-02, for consideration of the convenience store and associated alcohol sales and site development.

Census Tract 40.06

As already mentioned in this report, there is an undue concentration of ABC sales within Census Tract 40.06. Census Tract 40.06 encompasses properties north of Kearney Blvd., well beyond city limits and properties east of Madera Ave, well beyond city limits as shown in Attachment 'B'. At this time there are eight (8) Off-sale ABC licenses where only two (2) Off-sale ABC licenses are allowed in the census tract. Approval of this PCN would result in nine (9) Off-sale ABC licenses. The next closest ABC sales site is located within the Wal-Mart shopping center, which currently holds a Type 21 (Off-sale General). Of note, one of the eight (8) Off-sale ABC license's is located outside the City's sphere of influence.

The table shows all active ABC licenses in Census Tract 40.06.

<u>Findings</u>

In considering a Type 20 (Off-sale Beer and Wine) ABC license, the Council must determine that the request is warranted by a PCN, and Council must make a determination on whether or not a PCN would be served by the issuance of an off-sale ABC license prior to the issuance of a license by the State's Department of Alcohol Beverage Control.

To that end, applicants Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra (Fast N Easy) have submitted an application for a CUP and SPR in order to ensure compliance with the recently adopted ordinance related ABC sales. Moreover, ABC sales are generally incidental to convenience stores with fueling stations which

is a permitted use in commercial zone districts. At this time, staff has not been in receipt of any comments in favor or against the ABC license application due to the mandatory notice of application posted on the site.

Additional, the General Plan includes numerous goals and policies intended to help guide economic and community development in the City. The following policies directly or indirectly support the determination of the PCN in favor of the application.

- Policy ED 1.1 Increase Business. The City shall strive to increase the number of businesses
 operating in Kerman to satisfy the routine needs and dining, services, and retail desires of
 residents while also increasing sales, property, business, and potential transient-occupancy
 taxes.
- Policy ED 3.2 Expanding Operations and Employment. The City shall assist existing
 industries in expanding their operations and increasing employment in Kerman to reduce
 commutes.
- Policy ED 3.4 Attracting Industries for Local Jobs. The City shall seek industries that
 complement the existing workforce in terms of educational and vocational skills set and
 commute patterns, and will provide full-time, stable employment with competitive wages
 and benefits.

CEQA:

The proposed project is a commercial project pursuant to and in conformity with the Kerman 2040 General Plan. According to CEQA Guidelines Section 15183, a project that is consistent with a general plan required no further environmental review since it is consistent with the development density established by the 2040 General Plan for which an EIR was certified. There are no project-specific significant effects on the project or the site which would require additional environmental review. Accordingly, staff recommends that the Council find the project exempt from further review under CEQA.

RESOLUTION NO. 23-___

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KERMAN CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING FINDINGS OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE OR NECESSITY FOR A TYPE 20 OFF-SALE BEER AND WINE ABC LICENSE FOR VIKRAM VOHRA AND VINAY VOHRA (FAST N EASY) LOCATED AT 14195 W WHITESBRIDGE ROAD WHICH IS PENDING CONSIDERATION OF A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2023, the Community Development Department received a complete application for a Public Convenience or Necessity (PCN) request regarding an application for a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer & Wine) alcohol license (ABC license), from Vikram Vohra and Vinay Vohra (Fast N Easy) located at 14195 W Whitesbridge Rd.; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has determined that there is an undue concentration of off-sale ABC licenses in Census Tract 40.06 in which Fast N Easy wish to establish ABC sales; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that determination, California Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4 requires that "the local governing body of the area in which the applicant premises are located, or its designated subordinate officer or body, determines within 90 days of notification of a completed application that public convenience or necessity would be served by the issuance"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is the City's governing body and has the ability to make a determination of public convenience or necessity; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted an ordinance requiring all new ABC licenses to procure a Conditional Use Permit; and

WHEREAS, Fast N Easy has filed an application for an Alcohol Conditional Use Permit which review and consideration is pending; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023 the City Council makes findings of public convenience or necessity for a Type 20 Off-Sale Beer & Wine alcohol license; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Resolution does not pre-commit the City to approve a CUP for Fast N Easy.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kerman resolves as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The City Council hereby determines that public convenience or necessity would be served by the issuance of a Type 20 ABC license to Fast N Easy located at 14195 W Whitesbridge Rd. in the City of Kerman. The Council's determination is based on the following findings:

- a. The sale of beer and wine would serve the public convenience upon successfully procuring a Conditional Use Permit as required by Ordinance 23-02.
- b. Alcohol sales are an incidental activity within convenience stores with fueling stations which is a permitted use in commercial zone districts.
- c. The proposed use would stimulate economic activity by generating sales tax revenues, full- and part-time jobs while guiding community and economic goals and policies of the General Plan.
- d. Staff has not been in receipt of any comments in favor or against the ABC license application being issued as a result of the mandatory notice of application posted on the site.
- 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to submit a letter to ABC advising it of the Council's adoption of this Resolution to allow for the issuance of a Type 20 ABC license.
- 4. Approval of this Resolution does not pre-commit the City to issue a CUP to Fast N Easy.
- 5. This resolution is effective upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was approved by the City Council of the City of Kerman at a regular meeting held on the 22nd of February 2023, and passed at said meeting by the following vote:
