SUBJECT: Park and Facility Project Updates

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Philip Gallegos Park:

Installation of park amenities and signage is complete, hydro seeding is scheduled to take place and the park should be ready in 4-6 weeks. Staff will start planning for a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to take place in May.

Hart Ranch Park:

Tree removal has taken place on the first 15 acres. City Engineer is working on a contract for the removal of the trees on the next 10 acres.

New Park Rule Signs:

Park Rule signs have been updated and staff will be replacing and adding new signs to the parks. Kerckhoff Park was the first park to be updated with the new signs, Soroptimist Park is next on the replacement schedule.

California Trail:

Grading has begun on the housing development next to the California Trail, access to the trail from Park Avenue will soon be closed off as construction continues. Public Works staff have relocated the pet litter station to the Siskiyou entrance of the trail.
