I have homeowners that are having difficulties getting in and out of their driveways due to street parking on Alpine Ln in Ketchum. Due to this street being so tight and constant vehicles parked alongside the street/alley, they find it difficult to transit. They believe that these cars that are constantly parked on the street/alley are from a nearby construction. We just want to know if there is something that could be done about this or if there is nothing that prohibits these cars from parking there. Again, this issue has been going on for a while and is on Alpine Ln, close to the Second St E intersection.
