Eric Heringer noted he had received seven proposals from five banks. Zions Bank and JP Morgan-Chase were the best proposals. The proposals were ranks by interest rate with Zions Bank being ranked first at 1.73% interest rate and the offer was good for 60 days with prepayment allowed. Chase came in second with 1.723% with a \$9,000 upfront fee and no prepayment allowed.
